LEGACY THROUGH GIVING

To make **forward** a reality, all of us will be challenged to contribute in ways that are rare and significant. While faithful tithing/giving can supply a church's usual needs, only radical generosity can accomplish what is needed to reach **beyond ourselves** like this.

We invite you to consider things you may be able to sacrifice and give towards **forward**, and then make a comprehensive three-year commitment of your total generosity. This commitment will be above and **beyond** your normal giving.

Many of us have the capacity to give from accumulated resources/blessings God provided for us in the past that may be used to give to his purposes and plans today; stored resources could include savings accounts, valuables, stocks, tax returns, or property. Others will sacrifice funds from their annual budgets. However God leads you to participate, thank you for your investment in **building a legacy beyond ourselves**.

FAQs

O: HOW DOES FORWARD GIVING AFFECT MY REGULAR GIVING?

A: Forward is a generosity initiative that is over and beyond your regular giving. It is based on an additional annual generosity commitment, plus any stored assets you choose to give. These things total your 36-month commitment. During this three-year period, a portion of our regular budget will continue to go to our expansion plan, but **forward** is exclusively funding our new facility.

Q: WHEN WILL WE BE IN THE NEW BUILDING?

A: Our goal is to break ground no later than the fall of 2018 and the building process will be 18-24 months. Several factors contribute to this time-line, the most important of which is that we are good stewards of the resources God entrusts to us as a church. We will not break ground until Providence Church is at a place financially to do so. This is why the **forward** initiative is so important.

Q: WHEN IS THE BEST TIME FOR ME TO BEGIN CONTRIBUTING?

A: As soon as possible. The more generous our church is on the front end of forward, the quicker we can see this become a reality.

Q: WHO DO I CONTACT ABOUT DONATING STOCKS, INVESTMENTS, OR PROPERTY?

A: Simply email give@providence229.com to discuss the possibilities. Our finance team will guide you through the process.

Q: WHAT HAPPENS IF WE CONTINUE TO GROW AND WE NEED A LARGER FACILITY BY THE TIME WE MOVE IN?

A: The current facility is designed in phases. It can easily get larger with each environment getting the necessary square footage. In addition, one of the benefits of the position we are in with our new property is that we have more than enough space to grow and expand. We will also be able to add additional services as necessary with continued growth.

Q: WHEN WE DO OUTGROW THE NEW FACILITY, WHAT WILL BE THE NEXT STEP?

A: The current facility is designed in such a way that the auditorium will eventually become a larger kids facility for our older kids with small group rooms for them. At the necessary time, we will build a larger main auditorium to facilitate growth for adults.

Q: WHAT ABOUT OFFICE AND MEETING SPACES?

A: We currently have limited office space and our board, staff, and financial team have made the conscious choice to sacrifice offices until a later phase in order to provide the greatest ministry space possible. We have a plan for multi-use rooms for offices and meetings that will allow our needs to be fulfilled for the immediate future.

Q: WHAT WILL HAPPEN IF WE MISS OUR TARGET OF \$1 MILLION DOLLARS OVER THE NEXT THREE YEARS?

A: We expect to reach our goal, despite the challenge it represents! However, if we fall short, we will adjust expenditures and/or time-lines based on priorities determined by the elder board.

HOW CAN I GIVE? Giving sacrificially is challenging and may even seem overwhelming. However with prayer, creativity, and faith, giving to **forward** is possible for everyone! You may be able to use some of the following ideas to help you think creatively about giving to **forward**. These ideas are simply suggestions for you to use as a guide.

1// SMALL CHANGES

Eating out less often or drinking water instead of soda are small changes that yield big results. A family of four who eats out once a week and determines to drink water instead of ordering drinks, could save about \$400 per year.

2// REVIEW PRIORITIES

Postponing a planned expense like a new car, home remodel, or major purchase are ways of sacrifice. Choosing to rearrange current priorities and give up something in your current budget such as cable are also options. Even giving up a weekly trip to Starbucks could save hundreds over the course of a year.

3// REDIRECT PRESENT EX-PENDITURES

Once a short-term expense has ended, such as a loan or credit card bill, redirect this new cash flow into **forward**. Redirecting an average car payment upon paying it off would equal around \$4800 per year.

4// INCREASE GIVING WITH INCREASED INCOME

Sometimes we know of bonuses, raises, tax returns, or other events in our lives that will increase our cash flow in the next 12 months. Families can decide to delay increasing their lifestyle for a short period in order to give to the project.

5// DONATE ASSETS

There are some incredible tax advantages to giving appreciated assets, such as stock, bonds, or real estate.
